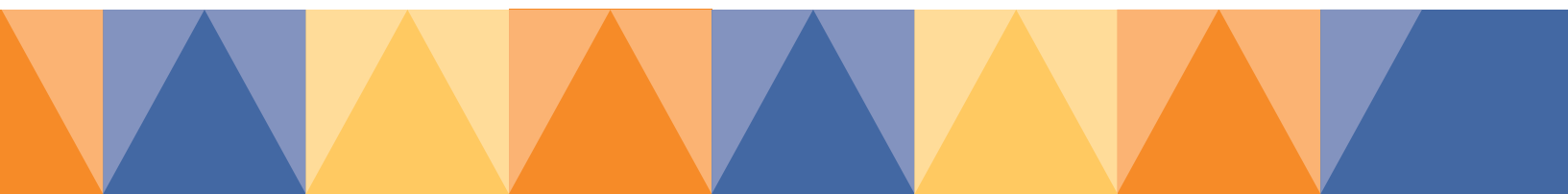
# SHOWCASING OUR VOLUNTEERS

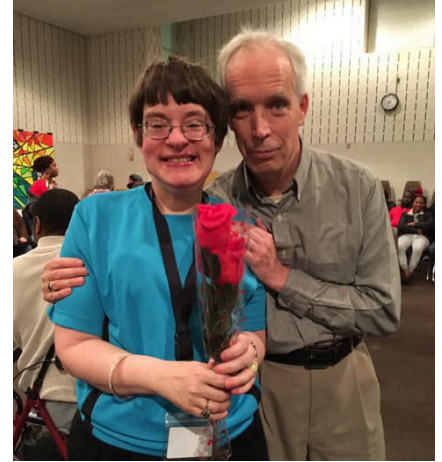


# CELEBRATING HOLIDAYS IN STYLE
